Stemilt's unique cherry season is the longest anywhere you go. It starts in early May and doesn't end until early September. You won't find another cherry season longer than ours!

Just Above Sea Level

Late April to mid June



World Famous Cherries kick off in California where sunny skies produce high-quality cherries with volume concentrated in the San Joaquin Valley including Brentwood and Stockton/River Delta which sit just below sea level. These cherries receive the wonderful benefits of chilling in the cool delta breeze.

Key Varieties: Coral, Garnet, Rainier, Royal Hazel, Bing, and Lapin

2,640' Elevation

Mid July to mid August



Stemilt Hill, WA

Famous for its volcanic soils and gradual elevation changes that extend harvest, Stemilt Hill is known for large, premium cherries.

Key Varieties:

Rainier, Skylar Rae®, Bing, Sweetheart, and Skeena



800' Elevation

Mid June to mid July



Mid-Columbia Basin, WA

This large district starts cherry season in Washington and includes company-run orchards in Pasco, Mattawa, and Quincy.

Key Varieties: Chelan, Santana™, Bing, Skeena, Rainier, and Skylar Rae®

Mid August to early September

Early to late July




North Central WA
